Spelling rules Ορθογραφικοί κανόνες

- 1 προσθέτουμε στο κύριο ρήμα την κατάληξη **-s**.
give → gives look → looks see → sees
- 2 προσθέτουμε στο κύριο ρήμα την κατάληξη **-es**, όταν το ρήμα τελειώνει σε **-ss, -sh, -ch, -x, -o**.
fix → fixes go → goes wash → washes
- 3 Όταν το ρήμα τελειώνει σε σύμφωνο + **-y**, αλλάζουμε το **-y** σε **-i** και ύστερα προσθέτουμε την κατάληξη **-es**.
cry → cries

Όμως: προσθέτουμε μόνο **-s**, όταν το ρήμα τελειώνει σε φωνήεν + **-y**.
