

O **Past Simple** χρησιμοποιείται για να περιγράψουμε πράξεις που άρχισαν και τελείωσαν σε συγκεκριμένο χρόνο στο παρελθόν.

I watched the race on TV last night.

Σχηματίζουμε τον **Past Simple** των ομαλών ρημάτων προσθέτοντας την κατάληξη -ed στο τέλος των ρημάτων στην κατάφαση: watch - watched. Τα ανώμαλα ρήματα έχουν δικό τους τύπο στην κατάφαση: go - went. Στην ερώτηση και την άρνηση χρησιμοποιούμε το βοηθητικό ρήμα did και did not (didn't) και το απαρέμφατο (ρήμα χωρίς κατάληξη).

- 1 δύο ή περισσότερες πράξεις που συνέβαιναν ταυτόχρονα στο παρελθόν. I **was watching** TV while my sister **was playing** on the computer.
- 2 μια πράξη που ήταν σε εξέλιξη σε συγκεκριμένη στιγμή στο παρελθόν. I **was** still **watching** the race at 10 oʻclock.
- 3 μια πράξη που βρισκόταν σε εξέλιξη στο παρελθόν και διακόπηκε από κάποια άλλη. Στην περίπτωση αυτή χρησιμοποιούμε **Past Simple** για την πράξη που διέκοψε αυτή που ήταν σε εξέλιξη. We **were eating** dinner when Grandpa **called**.
